INTRODUCTION

Records do not always reveal reality or actuality. They're only a representation of what someone else decides is fact. Thus, this volume may (undoubtedly) contain some inaccuracies. It is very difficult to produce a genealogical book of this size and scope without unintentionally including mistakes. I apologize for these. Absolute accuracy is impossible when dealing with such unreliable and variable a subject as people are. Names and spellings, dates of birth and death, and marriages are always subject to inaccuracies. This is especially prevalent the further back in time you search. And, is due in part to the numbers of individuals who have compiled records lists previously. Sometimes a mistake can even be attributed to the originator of the record; a clerk, minister, etc. With every passing generation the oral histories as well as family traditions, those "little scraps of paper" kept by family members, sometimes in Bibles, are lost, unless retrieved, preserved, organized and compiled. I have attempted to do just that; compiling everything I've found.

The Federal Census records from 1790-1900 have been used extensively in discovering and grouping family members into their proper line. The 1790-1840 Censuses only list the head of household/family and list all other members of the household by age groupings and gender. From 1850-1900 all members of a household are named, aged, gendered, etc. My biggest problem was in identifying and placing each family member in their proper line of descent. Luckily, we've had previous works and biographies to aid in this task. And, the 1880 and 1900 Federal Censuses list the relationship to the head of the household for each member of the household, as well as the birth places of each individual's parents, years married, number of children each woman has had and how many are still living, widowed, single or divorced, and occupations.

The following is an explanation of the use of symbols found within these pages. The use of parenthesis indicates: 1. when used with a spouse married into the family, they contain the spouse's birth date and location, and death date and location. 2. when used with a person's names, the name in parenthesis is a nickname which the individual was better known by. 3. when used with dates, the actual date is in question. 4. when used with locations, the actual location is in question. 5. when used with a proper name, the name is not definite but thought to be correct. It is the most often found. The use of a slash line / indicates: 1. when used with names, there is confusion as to which name is the original or real name. Both have been found as the true name. The first one is thought to be most likely the correct one (example: James/Jarvis). 2. when used with the same name, the spelling of that name is in question. 3. when used with a place or date, the place or date is in question. The real one is one of those listed. The first one most likely being correct, or, is found most often (example: 1807/1808/1809). The use of a long straight line (—) with a spouse's first or last name, indicates that the name is unknown.

The most important single document I've found and use is the 1900 Federal Census. It contains a tremendous amount of information. Besides listing first and last names often middle names are also given. The birth month, year and age, and sometimes even the day of birth are

given. The place of birth (state or country), and sometimes a town or county are given. The relationship to the head of the household, if married, single, divorced or widowed, place of births of parents, number of years married, number of children each woman has had and the number still living, occupations of each person, and the exact location of residence are all given in the 1900 Federal Census records.

The importance of census records lies in having a location pinpointed for searching for additional information, such as, birth, death, marriage and cemetery records for an individual.

This is a working manuscript. It is to be used as a basis for the addition of new information. The primary purpose for my compiling this manuscript is to preserve our family history. No history should ever be lost. True history is the study of individuals who collide with each other at points in time producing incidents and events of major and minor importance. Genealogy is the history of groups of these individuals united by blood.

I dedicate this manuscript to my Great-Great-Great-Great-Grandmother, Rachel Demaree-Ryker-Van Cleave.

RYKER

GERARDUS RYKER: b. November 16, 1740, at Closter, Bergen Co., New Jersey, d. September 15, 1781, at Bullskin, Jefferson (now Shelby) Co., Kentucky, the son of John Rycken and Geertie/Grietie Wiltsee. m. November 17/20, 1762, at New York City, New York, to RACHEL DEMAREE (b. November 19, 1743, in Bucks Co., Pennsylvania (bp. April 1, 1744, at Hampton, Bucks Co., Pennsylvania), d.c. 1814?, in Jefferson Co., Indiana), the daughter of Samuel Demaree/Demarest and Lea Demarest. Gerardus served in the American Army during the American Revolutionary War. He firstly served as an Ensign in Major Mauritius Goetschius' Battalion of New Jersey Militia. He served secondly as a Lieutenant in Colonel Teunis Dey's Bergen Co., New Jersey Militia. In the spring of 1780 Gerardus and Rachel joined her father and brothers and sisters in the move to Kentucky Territory. Rachel's sister Antjin m. Hendrick Banta. Her sister Elizabeth m. Daniel Harris. Her sister Tryntie (Katherine) m. Jacob Smock. The Banta, Harris, Smock, Ryker and Van Cleave families were much intermarried. Gerardus was killed by Indians during the engagement known as Floyd's Defeat. Militiamen under the command of Colonel Floyd rode out to rescue the survivors of the Long Run Massacre but incountered a large band of hostile Indians, who with there first volley of gun fire, decimated their ranks. Gerardus died and is buried near present boarder of Shelby and Jefferson Counties. After his death Rachel, fearfull of the Indians, moved her three sons and four daughters into Fort Hackett, located on Bullskin Creek. She remarried c. 1783, to John Van Cleave (b. 1739, in Monmouth Co., New Jersey, d. May 12, 1812, in Jefferson Co., Indiana), the son of Aaron Van Cleave and Rachel Schenck. John had lost his first wife in the Long Run Massacre Indian uprising. John is listed in the 1790, 1800 and 1810 Federal Censuses for Kentucky as living in Jefferson Co. (in an area which became Shelby County in 1792), and in Shelby Co. They moved to Ryker's Ridge, Madison Twp., Jefferson Co., Indiana in 1811. It is assumed that John Van Cleave and Rachel Demaree-Ryker-Van Cleave are buried in the Ryker's Ridge Cemetery, in Madison Twp., Jefferson Co., Indiana.

JOHN RYKER: b. January 18, 1764, at Closter, Bergen Co./Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey (bp. February 12, 1764, at the Reformed Dutch Church, at Tappan, Rockland Co., New York/Old Tappan, Bergen Co., New Jersey) (both are only a couple of miles apart), d. November 22, 1848, at Madison, Jefferson Co., Indiana, the son of Gerardus Riker/Rycken and Rachel Demaree/Demarest. m. (firstly) June 16, 1784, in Lincoln Co., Kentucky, to Mary Van Cleave (b. May 16, 1766, at Mocksville, Rowan (now Davie) Co., North Carolina, d. March 8, 1838, at Madison, Jefferson Co., Indiana), the daughter of Benjamin Van Cleave and Ruth Munson. m. (secondly) July 3, 1838, in Jefferson Co., Indiana, to Amelia (Milly) Littlejohn (b. 1809, in North Carolina). John is listed in the 1790 Federal Census for Kentucky as living in Jefferson Co. He is listed in the 1794 thru 1804 Kentucky State Tax lists as living in Shelby Co., on Bullsken Creek, owning 100 acres of land, and owning 4 horses and 5 cattle. John was the second permanent settler in Jefferson Co., Indiana. He arrived in 1804, but was forced to return to Kentucky several times due to Indian confrontations. He settled near the mouth of Eagle Creek, and was living there when visited by William Robbins, his nephew. John purchased land on April 24, 1809, located in the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 30, township 4, north range 11 east. He had a blockhouse on his farm in 1815. In the summer of 1815 there was a false Indian scare. The news had just reached Madison, Indiana of the end to the War of 1812. This caused a number of people to shoot off their guns in celebration. The Ryker families living above Madison on what was officially called Ryker's Ridge heard all the shooting and presumed it was an Indian attack. The men placed their families in John's blockhouse and hurried down to town to join the fight thought to be under way. Upon arrival they found a free whisky end-of-war celebration. The Ryker men naturally got drunk. They didn't head for home until after dark, and in a very noisy condition. The women in the blockhouse thought them to be Indians attacking under the cover of night. A short time later the women realized that the noisy 'Indians' were really their absent husbands. John was a Colonel in the Kentucky "Cornstalk" Militia. He was appointed Overseer of the Poor of Madison Twp., Jefferson Co., Indiana, on April 10, 1817. He is listed in the 1820, 1830 and 1840 Federal Censuses for Indiana as living in Jefferson Co., Madison Twp., and being a farmer. John's will is dated May 26, 1847, Madison, Jefferson Co., Indiana. It was probated on May 24, 1849, in Madison, Jefferson Co., Indiana. Amelia is listed in the 1850 Federal Census for Indiana as living in Jefferson Co., Madison Twp., next to Aaron Van Cleave, the son of Peter Van Cleave, a half brother of John Ryker. She was living with her daughter Mary in 1860. John and Mary are buried in the Old Ryker's Ridge Cemetery, in Madison Twp., Jefferson Co., Indiana.
