LEAH RYKER: b. November 28, 1765, in Bergen Co., New Jersey (bp. December 25, 1765), d. November 24, 1844, in Jefferson Co., Indiana, the daughter of Gerardus Riker/Rycken and Rachel Demaree/Demarest. m. (fall or winter) 1787, at Bull Skin (Shelbyville), Shelby Co., Kentucky, to Emanuel Meddock/Medak (b. 1759/60, d. January 11, 1829, in Jefferson Co., Indiana). Leah, also called Lear and Leath, may have died in 1833 or August 20, 1834 (these may have been dates of death for two of her children). She may have remarried May 11, 1829, in Jefferson Co., Indiana, to James Crockett. Emanuel's name is also found spelled as: Maddock, Medaugh and Meadow. He served in the American Army during the American Revolutionary War. He enlisted 1777, at Newark, New Jersey, as a Private, in Captain John Noble Cummings' Company, Colonel Israel Shreve's 2nd New Jersey Regiment. He enlisted again on January 11, 1779 or February 6, 1779, at Newark, New Jersey, in Captain Redden's/Reading's Company, Colonel John Noble Cummings' Regiment. He was in the battles of: Brandywine, Germantown, Monmouth, Newtown, the engagement at Little York, and the taking of General Burgoyne. He was discharged December 18, 1781 or February 12, 1782, in New Jersey. He petitioned for a pension in 1811, stating he was a farmer, owning one horse and 30 hogs. A pension was allowed June 22, 1818. He is listed in the 1810 Federal Census for Kentucky as living in Shelby Co. In 1811 he was living in Milton Twp., Jefferson Co., Indiana. He owned 80 acres of land located in Shelby Twp., Jefferson Co., Indiana. He is listed in the 1820 Federal Census for Indiana as living in Jefferson Co. It is assumed that three grandchildren were living with him in 1820 (one male, b.b. 1810-1820, and two females, b.b. 1810-1820). He wrote his will in June 1820. Emanuel is buried in the Fugit Graveyard, located between two bridges at Manville, Milton Twp., Jefferson Co., Indiana. There is only one headstone left, erected by the D.A.R., and only says Revolutionary Soldier.

LEAH RYKER: b. November 28, 1765, in Bergen Co., New Jersey (bp. December 25, 1765), d. November 24, 1844, in Jefferson Co., Indiana, the daughter of Gerardus Riker/Rycken and Rachel Demaree/Demarest. m. (late fall or early winter) 1787, at Bull Skin (Shelbyville), Jefferson (Shelby) Co., Kentucky, to Emanuel Meddack (b. 1759/60, d. January 4/11, 1829, in Jefferson Co., Indiana. They were married at the home of her mother and stepfather, John Van Cleave, on Bull Skin Creek. Leah, also called Lear and Leath, may have died in late 1833 or circa August 20, 1834. These dates have been attributed to her but may in fact be dates of death for two of her children. She remarried on May 11, 1829, in Jefferson Co., Indiana, to James Crockett. Emanuel's name is also found spelled as: Meddock, Maddock, Medack, Medaugh and Meadow. He served in the American Army during the American Revolutionary War. He enlisted in 1777, at Newark, New Jersey, as a Private, in Captain John Noble Cummings' Company, Colonel Israel Shreve's 2nd New Jersey Regiment of the Continental Army. He was transferred, or re-enlisted, on January 11, 1779 or February 6, 1779, at Newark, New Jersey, in Captain Redden's/Reading's Company, Colonel John Noble Cummings' Regiment. He was in the battles of: Brandywine, Germantown, Monmouth, Newtown, the engagement at Little York, and the taking of General Burgoyne. He was discharged December 18, 1781 or February 12, 1782, at Battle Hill, New Jersey. He petitioned for a pension for his war service in 1811; stating that he was a farmer living in Milton Twp., Jefferson Co., Indiana, owning one horse, one cow and calf, and 30 hogs. A pension was allowed him on June 22, 1818. He is listed in the 1810 Federal Census for Kentucky as living in Shelby Co. He is listed in the 1820 Federal Census for Indiana as living in Jefferson Co. Here he owned 80 acres of land located in Shelby Twp. It is assumed that three grandchildren were living with him in 1820 (one male, b.b. 1810-1820, and two females, b.b. 1810-1820). He wrote his will in June 1823. Emanuel is buried in the Fugit Graveyard, located between two bridges, at Manville, Milton Twp., Jefferson Co., Indiana. There is only one headstone left, erected by the D.A.R., and only says "Revolutionary Soldier."

Philip Eastin, — Johnson and — Bailey perpetrated fraud by attempting to obtain a pension from Emanuel's Revolutionary War service through a ruse in claiming guardianship of Gerardus. William Crawford Ryker brought the scheme to the government's attention and prosecution, in Jefferson Co., Indiana.

GERARDUS RYKER: b. November 4, 1767, at Closter, Bergen Co., New Jersey (bp. December 6, 1767, at the Reformed Dutch Church, at Tappan, Rockland Co., New York/Old Tappan, Bergen Co., New Jersey) (both are only a couple of miles apart), d. January 7, 1839, in Jefferson Co., Indiana, the son of Gerardus Riker/Rycken and Rachel Demarest/Demaree. m. (firstly) June 27, 1788, in Kentucky, to Polly Galloway. This marriage maybe incorrect. It is attributed to a Jacob, but I believe the spelling was really Jared, which is short for Gerardus. m. (secondly) May 5, 1791, in Mercer Co., Kentucky, to Leah Smock (b. April 8, 1774, in Pennsylvania (bp. May 15/18, 1774, at Conewago, Pennsylvania), d. October 4, 1858, in Jefferson Co., Indiana, the daughter of Jacob Smock and Tryntie Demarest. Gerardus and Leah were second* cousins. Gerardus is listed in the 1790 Federal Census for Kentucky as living in Jefferson Co. He lived in an area which became Shelby County in 1792. He is listed in the 1794 thru 1806 Kentucky State Tax Lists and the 1800 Federal Census for Kentucky as living in Shelby Co., owning 100 acres of land on Bullskin Creek, two horses and nine cattle. He moved* to the area of Clark Co., Indiana, near Jeffersonville, between 1809-1811. He served as a Private in Colonel McFarland's Detachment of Indiana Militia during the War of 1812. Prior to 1817 Gerardus moved up to Jefferson Co., Indiana, being one of the earliest to settle in the area. Here he became a Justice-of-the-Peace in 1817. He is listed in the Indiana Register of Receipts Land Office records as purchasing 80 acres of land on August 4, 1817, and 78.5 acres of land on July 3, 1818. Both parcels of land were located in Jefferson Co., Indiana. Gerardus is listed in the Jeffersonville Land Office receipts as purchasing land on September 24, 1827, in section 6, township 3, north range 9 east, for \$78.95. Gerardus is listed in the 1820 and 1830 Federal Censuses for Indiana as living in Jefferson Co. Leah is listed in the 1840 Federal Census for Indiana as living in Jefferson Co., Madison Twp. She was living with her son John in the same location in 1850. As a teen-ager in Kentucky, prior to marriage, Leah was captured by Indians. They scalped her, but she escaped, and was rescued. Gerardus and Leah are buried in the Ryker's Ridge Cemetery, in Madison Twp., Jefferson Co., Indiana.

John is listed in the 1820, 1830, 1840, 1850, 1860 and 1870 Federal Censuses for Indiana as living in Jefferson Co., Shelby Twp. (in 1840), Madison Twp. (in 1850, 1860 and 1870), and being a farmer. He wrote his will on August 17, 1871, and it was probate in 1875. John and Sarah are buried in the Ryker's Ridge Cemetery.

Anna was considered to be a very estimable and clever woman. Jared, Elizabeth and Anna are buried in the Ryker's Ridge Cemetery.
